End of Term Letter

As we come to the end of term, I reflect with immense pride following our first full year without the severe lockdown restrictions that have dominated recent times. Though, we have continued to see cases of Covid-19 within the community, I remain astounded by the resilience and positive approach that our students have demonstrated throughout, whether this be Year 11 sitting their GCSE exams or those who have helped ensure the school theatre productions have gone ahead as planned. Our school community, students and staff alike, have truly embodied our school values of Excellence and Kindness.

We have been very successful in securing funding from the Department for Education to continue to develop the school premises; in September, our students will be taught in state-of-the-art science labs in a block that will also include a 60-seater demonstration auditorium. We are also excited to start further developments to refurbish the leisure centre facility over the coming months. These projects will transform the learning environment of Rudheath Senior Academy and will, quite literally, open their eyes to the world of possibility.

As many of you will know, we will all welcome our new Head Teacher to Rudheath in September. Mr James Kerfoot will join from Accrington Academy, bringing a wealth of experience as a senior leader. I have had the pleasure of working with Mr Kerfoot over recent months and we are all excited to welcome him to our community after the summer break.

To celebrate the of this academic year, I am delighted to invite all staff, students, governors and trust staff to a BBQ event at 11.30am on Tuesday 19th July, the last day of term. This day will be a non-uniform day for students and there will be a number of outdoor activities, including sport and music for students to take part in. We hope this will be an enjoyable start to the summer holidays. School will close at 12.45pm on Tuesday 19th July and all students will exit via the Shipbrook Road entrance/exit.

You may be aware that a red weather warning for Extreme Heat has been issued for Monday 18th July and Tuesday 19th July. This means that it is expected that there will be exceptional, perhaps record-breaking, temperatures likely on both days. With this in mind, students are encouraged to wear their PE kit on Monday 18th July for an activities day, and loose, light coloured clothing on Tuesday 19th July. Sunscreen should be used to protect skin and students and encouraged to bring a water bottle; we will provide water to refill bottles from the canteen or the staffroom.

Timing of the School Day

As you will know from my previous communication, we have consulted with all stakeholders regarding the length of the school day.
