Pitch means the Highness and Lowness of a Sound

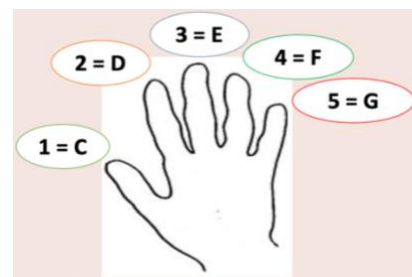
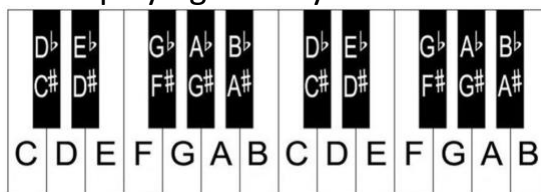
- Smaller, shorter, thinner and tighter instruments make more high-pitched sounds.
- Larger and longer instruments make more low-pitched sounds.
